## **Compliance with European RoHS Directive**

European directive 2002/95/EC, Restriction of the use of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (RoHS), came into effect on 1 July 2006. The RoHS directive restricts the use of substances in products placed on the market in the European Economic Area (EEA). Substances restricted by the directive include:

- Lead
- Mercury
- Cadmium
- Hexavalent Chromium
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB)
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE)

Terrasat Communications has taken actions necessary to bring all current products and accessories into compliance with the RoHS directive and procedures are in place to ensure ongoing compliance. It should be noted that an exemption is in place for lead in solders for certain electronic equipment. This exemption applies to Terrasat products. Restrictions on other substances are applicable and our actions have been focused on full compliance. Products shipped after the 1 July 2006 effective date will be labeled and/or annotated on accompanying documents regarding RoHS compliance.

The following specific actions have been taken to bring Terrasat products into compliance:

- 1) Identification of product components containing restricted substances,
- 2) Selection and certification of replacement parts for components containing restricted substances,
- 3) Documentation of replacement components in all manufacturing and procurement documents and procedures,
- 4) Procurement and use of compliant components,
- 5) Implementation of procedures to verify that components received are compliant and obtained from approved vendors,
- 6) Documentation and labeling to provide means of determining compliance after products enter the markets.

Terrasat Communications is fully committed to responsible manufacturing practices that preserve the environment. In addition, human health and safety are regarded as corporate priorities in the conduct of manufacturing operations. Compliance with the European RoHS directive is, therefore, consistent with the policies and commitments of Terrasat Communications.
